General – We seek a student who is interested in pursuing an education and career working in natural resources. The candidate could be pursuing a degree in a variety of majors, including but not limited to: environmental science, ecology, forestry, wildlife and fisheries management, biology, zoology, animal sciences, botany, agronomy; agriculture, natural resources and conservation. Invasive species management includes hand-pulling plants, using hand tools, identifying plants, collecting data on invasive plant distribution, and other management activities under the direction of the Invasive Species Management Technician. Recreation activities include trail maintenance and assisting with recreation programs for kids. Real Estate activities include boundary maintenance/marking and checking on the status of numerous matters including encroachments. On days with inclement weather, office duties will include working with GIS, filing real estate records in the vault, searching town land records, and other office work.
