The intern has opportunities to learn about and contribute to a variety of ongoing projects in the Paintings and Sculpture Department, including but not limited to:

- Research on the Center's art collection
- Assistance with research requests from curators and other museum staff
- Assistance with updating information in the Center's collections database (TMS)
- Assistance with selecting and researching potential works of art for exhibitions or gallery installations
- Assist with writing labels for works to be displayed

Qualifications

The position is open to a currently rising sophomore, junior, or senior with a keen interest in museums, galleries, or art history as a potential career option. Must be available to work Monday through Friday for 30 to 37.5 hours/week. Employment is contingent upon successful completion of background and credit checks.

- Excellent computer skills; proficient in MS Office, particularly Word
- High level of discretion and confidentiality to museum information
- Interest in developing research skills
